Rules of Spirit and Roll Call 2015

Are you ready to scream at the top of your lungs, lose your voice, and dress up like you're crazy? Then you're ready for convention 2015 spirit! The overall goal of spirit is to have fun and show your energy, so we hope everybody participates and has a blast! Here are the rules of the spirit competition:

- 1. Using the school signs placed by your area is not permitted- do not wave them!
- 2. No tossing anything! No bubbles and no noisemakers.
- 3. Nothing inappropriate (inappropriate dress, violence, vulgarity, etc.).
 - a. Full shirts, shoes, and arm-length pants are required to be considered for a spirit prize.
- 4. Standing on chairs is not safe and not allowed. You will be disqualified from the Spirit competition if you do.
- 5. Schools will be categorized based on the number of delegates as Small, Medium, or Large.
- 6. Spirit is judged fifteen minutes before General Assemblies, not in the procession to the assemblies.
- 7. Points will be deducted for violation of rules and inappropriate conduct.
- 8. Prizes are awarded to the most creative and awesome delegations, as well as those who truly reflect the awesomeness that is the JCL.

Roll Call

In roll call a limit of two delegates from every school comes up to the podium and can use creative and fun ways to share the following information: School name, number of delegates, number of chaperones, number of sponsors, and total number of attendees.

The official rules of roll call are:

- 1. Rules 1-3 and 6-7 of spirit apply to roll call (except that noisemakers are allowed).
- 2. Each state delegation is allowed to send a maximum of two students for roll call.
- 3. Each delegation has 30 seconds (strict maximum), and should include their school name, # of delegates, # of chaperones, # of sponsors, and their total # of attendees.
