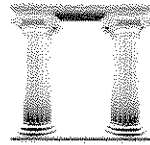

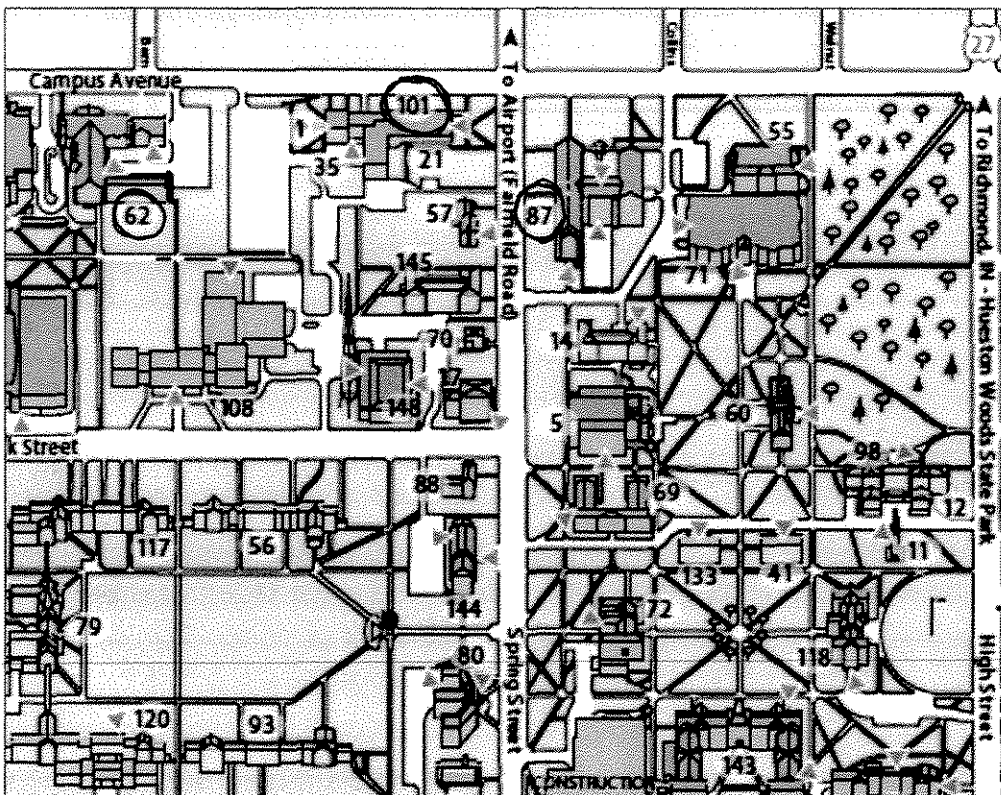

Permit Usage Guidelines:

- Place on dashboard driver side. Make sure this permit is visible from outside vehicle.
- Please AVOID parking any part of your vehicle on a yellow curb; vehicles parked on a yellow curb may be ticketed.
- Garage fees must be paid upon exit. There is no overnight parking in garages.
- All parking meters must be paid to avoid citations.
- Do not alter permit in any way; citations may be issued.
- This permit allows you to park in any legal space on campus excluding those reserved for state vehicles.
- Always display your state issued handicapped placard when parking in a space reserved for those with disabilities.
