UPDATED RULES

In addition to the rules listed below, all schools are now required to submit a video of the roll call skit that they intend to perform to treasurer@ojcl.org by Wednesday, February 22nd at 11:59pm. Videos must be uploaded to YouTube, and a link to the video must be submitted to the Treasurer. If you do not want your video to be public, you can change the privacy setting so that only people with the link can see it (“Unlisted”).

IF YOU DO NOT SUBMIT A VIDEO OF YOUR ROLL CALL TO THE TREASURER, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PERFORM A ROLL CALL FOR YOUR SCHOOL.

The official rules of roll call are:

1. The school signs placed by the OJCL in your school’s area are NOT permitted to be used in roll call.
2. No tossing anything. No bubbles!
3. Nothing inappropriate (inappropriate dress, violence, vulgarity, etc.).
 - a. Full shirts, shoes, and arm-length pants are required.
4. Each delegation can send a maximum of two students for roll call.
5. Each delegation has 30 seconds (strict maximum – you will be cut off if you go over!), and should include their school name, # of delegates, # of chaperones, # of sponsors, and their total # of attendees.
6. Roll call will be judged by the state officers. The winners will receive a prize!
7. Points will be deducted for violation of rules and inappropriate conduct.
