

Classical Literacy Exam

Application Deadline: January 22, 2018 **Cost:** \$1 per student **Testing:** Feb. 1-28, 2018

Format: Students provide the term that answers the question. For study purposes, a complete list of terms and phrases is provided on the Classical Exams website.

e.g. On what hill in ancient Athens did the Parthenon stand? **Answer:** Acropolis

Teachers determine the appropriate level of testing for each student, grade their own students' exams, and report results. Four levels of difficulty.

Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals are awarded on Levels I-III, ribbons awarded for the Introductory Level, and templates provided for sponsors to print their own certificates.

Students may also choose to take the challenging *Classical Scholar's Exam*, which will focus exclusively on Homer's *Odyssey* this year.
