

1. Eligibility for Appointed Offices

a. Section 5.02

i. Proposed Addition: “F. If fewer than two chapters are eligible to sponsor a candidate for a specific appointed office, Article V Section 2.C of the OJCL Constitution will be waived for that individual office.”

ii. For Reference: “C: No chapter may sponsor a candidate for an office, which a member of that chapter holds at the time of that candidate's election or appointment.”

iii. Purpose: For many years, it has been impossible under the current rules for there to ever be more than one candidate for the Central Gubernator office. This leads to a situation where there is only one candidate able to be appointed, regardless of their qualifications. With this change, at least 2 schools would be able to sponsor a candidate, adding at least some level of competition and selection to the process.
