

Summit Latin Wins the State Championship Again!

The results are finally in for the Ohio Junior Classical League convention! Over 350 students from 26 OH schools participated. The 24 Summit Latin students earned a number of overall awards.


- 1st Place in Overall Points: Summit earned 1182 points, over 400 more than the 2nd place school! This proves the old adage, Labor Omnia Vincit.
- 1st Place in Total Per Capita: Summit students averaged 47 total points per student, 5 more than the 2nd place team.
- 3rd Place in Academic Per Capita: Summit students averaged 22 academic point per student, just 2 points away from the 1st place team.
- 1st Place in Level 1 Certamen: Emily Bolan, Hana Conte, Callie Fox, and Aaron Fraley.
- 2nd Place in Upper Level Certamen: Irene Calderon, Jimmy Fraley, Wali Khan, and Kendall Richard.
- Superior Rating on a Number of Club Projects (superior is the highest ranking):
 - Banner (created by Kendall Richard)
 - Commercial (Ancient Olympics theme – written and directed by Katie Dobelhoff, edited by Jimmy Fraley)
 - Digital Scrapbook (edited by Mia Rahner)
 - Community Service
